University of Peradeniya News



The University of Peradeniya Secures Top Spot in Sri Lanka for UI GreenMetric 2024

The University of Peradeniya proudly claims the top position in Sri Lanka, ranks 10th in South Asia, 101st in Asia, and 192nd globally in the prestigious UI GreenMetric World University Ranking 2024. With an impressive total score of 8,050 out of 10,000, the university has earned its place among the elite 309 Gold Cluster Universities. Notably, the University of Peradeniya has advanced by 87 positions globally compared to 2023, reflecting its unwavering commitment to sustainability and continuous improvement.



The World's Top 2% Scientists from University of Peradeniya!

Stanford University's list of "World's Top 2%" scientists is based on a 2% or above percentile rank, or the top 100,000 by c-score (with and without self-citations). This prestigious list identifies the world's leading researchers, representing approximately 2% of all scientists worldwide. It encompasses standardized data on citations, h-index, and a wide range of bibliometric indicators. Researchers are classified into 22 scientific fields and 174 sub-fields, drawing from Scopus data provided by Elsevier.



Inaugural National Sustainable Tourism Conference (NSTC 2024)

The inaugural National Sustainable Tourism Conference (NSTC 2024), a collaborative effort between the Department of Trade, Commerce & Tourism, Central Province, and the Department of Geography, University of Peradeniya, took place successfully on December 17, 2024, at the Department of Geography, University of Peradeniya. The event brought together a vibrant mix of academics, policymakers, industry leaders, and students to explore sustainable tourism practices under the theme, "Harmony of Culture, Heritage, and Nature: Towards Sustainable Tourism in Sri Lanka."

Bhutanese students got enrolled for MBBS in the Faculty of Medicine

Ten Bhutanese students got enrolled in the Faculty of Medicine, University of Peradeniya on 02.12.2024 to pursue MBBS degree programme. All of them are top ranked in the university entrance examinations in Bhutan and have been sent here on the memorandum of understanding between the Royal Government of Bhutan and the University of Peradeniya. This year marks the 20th anniversary of the MOU signed between the Royal Kingdom of Bhutan and the University of Peradeniya.

75th Anniversary of the Geneva Conventions: Photo Exhibition & Panel Discussion

A photo exhibition, commemorating the 75th anniversary of the Geneva Conventions, was declared open at the New Library Building on the 29th of November 2024. The exhibition is organized by the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), in collaboration with the University of Peradeniya. The Geneva Conventions, adopted in 1949, represent the most significant attempt made by the international community to establish a legal framework that ensures the protection of people who are most vulnerable in times of war; i.e. civilians, prisoners of war, the wounded, and the sick.

Maker Faire 2024: The IoE exhibition

Students showcased their learning outcomes of Microcontroller (Arduino, Raspberry pi, etc.) based implementations exploring the Internet of Everything (IoE) concepts. This year, 18 student groups from the Computer Science 2nd year batch demonstrated their exhibits, ranging from medical drones, robotic arms, and CPR and AED training kits to smart greenhouses and smart blind sticks. They were based on various applications like medicine, agriculture, engineering, etc.

Guidelines for topics and content of materiel/creations to be published under the banner, Alumni Association of the University of Peradeniya – GTA and Suburbs

- 1. These guidelines have been developed to provide opportunity for alumni members and the families to contribute with their creativity and knowledge to the publications of the Alumni Association of the University of Peradeniya GTA & Suburbs whilst ensuring credibility of the Association.
- 2. Types of publications may include, but not be restricted to, the Newsletter, event magazines, magazines on special topics or general topics, arts, collections, scientific journals, photos and video publications, contest results, informative documents, interviews etc.
- 3. The decision to publish or not will be determined by the Association's editorial board (President, Secretary, Past President & 02 Communication Leads of BOM) and their decision will be final. If needed, the Association may appoint a specialized editorial board depending on the theme/subject matter.
- 4. The material can be in the form of write-up, poem, quiz, cartoons, photographs, pictorials, or any other similar material, but should not be excessive in length, size etc. It is desirable to have themes associated with the University of Peradeniya or higher education, but this condition does not restrict materials of any other relevant topics. Time to time the Association may invite contributions to suggested themes/topics.
- 5. The articles can be written in English, Sinhalese, or Tamil.
- 6. The material should not promote/support any political or religious views/activities OR any social activity that can directly or indirectly lead to engagement, promotion, or participation of any political or religious activity or incite friction or violence.
- 7. As far as possible the material should be original and it is the responsibility of the author to retain evidence pertaining to any reference, quotations etc. made in the material. The author also undertakes to produce such material if requested by the editorial board.
- 8. The material should not be self-promoting or directly/indirectly, discrediting/disrespecting any individual/s living or dead or promoting hate behaviour, violence etc.
- 9. Once received, the Association retains the right to use the material for promotion of the Association or its activities.
- 10. Whilst the Association will make every effort to publish all the material conforming to the above terms, due to exceptional reasons, including decisions of the editorial board etc., some material may not be published in the alumni publications. Any such material will be returned to the author as soon as practical.
- 11. Any other governance rules issued time to time by the Association will supersede content of this document.

These guidelines are not intended to restrict creativity, but have been developed in the spirit of transparent working principles of the Association. We therefore request your cooperation in adhering to them in the right 'Peradeniya Spirit'.

- RECOGNIZE ACHIVEMENTS
- COMMUNICATE & INTERACT
- CONTRIBUTE TO ADVANCEMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN SRI LANKA
- The Association shall not engage or promote or participate in any political or religious activities OR any social activity that can directly
 or indirectly lead to engagement, promotion, or participation of any political or religious activity and/or in conflict with the above
 objectives. Any exception will be evaluated by the Board of Management based on merits. However, this principle does not aim at
 restricting any individual choices.
