

Work Plans - Mandate

The working committee has converted all the big ideas to workable mandates and appointed sub-committees to develop implementable proposals. It is planned to submit the priority proposals to the alumni membership for further refinement before embark on implementation.

1. Social Gathering

Define need, Nature of unique event (Peradeniya theme, appeal to multiple cultures/generations etc), Timing advantages/disadvantages, Duration, Location, Resources, Budgets, Risks/sensitivities

2. New Immigrants Induction and Settling Down Program

Scope of help on key must know, must do before and after arrival as a process from leaving, arrival, interim help, settling down, net-working and other requirements

3. Employable skills development

Employment environment challenges, key disadvantages, past experience of the old immigrants, potential opportunity areas, defining core transition skills, defining core employable skills, defining/recommending relevant programs, Resourcing the programs, Research required, Resources, Budgets, risks/sensitivities etc

4. Recruiter Day and liaison

Recruiter landscape, study of their approach, target group, target Govt. Groups, Common and specific areas of development for Alumni members/spouses, Recognition of development activities, relevant program incl. Peradeniya brand, resource requirements, Budgets, risks/sensitivities

5. Corporate Benefit Program

Define the scope of areas, the requirements to quality, targeted institutes, nature of benefits, minimum requirements to qualify, contact details, Conditions to activate the program, resources, budgets, risks/sensitivities

6. Academic Internship and Post Graduate sponsorship

Define the concept and scope of potential areas, lessons from past, targeted institutes/universities/faculties, targeted decision makers, define value/selling proposition, opportunity for bilateral or unilateral program, program enablers, and program initiation methods

7. Support Advancement of Academic Scope of Peradeniya University

Clarify the current status of Peradeniya academic programs, landscape of modern university education, gap statement, and potential target areas, identify a pilot program/s, developing value propos ion to university authorities, key stake holder list, introduction approach (direct/indirect/Hybrid)

8. Children's talent Recognition

Definition of talents, selection criteria, selection method/categories, selection panel, application method with proper proof, period of recognition, mode of recognition, publication method, awards, awards ceremony or any other method, budgets, resources, risk/sensitivities

9. Teens skills development and Recognition of Exceptional Talents of Alumni members

Proposal to be developed covering the following as minimum: Define the need, target group, core skills, core curriculum aspects, program/s, resources, timing, recognition and validity, follow up program, Budgets, resources, risks/sensitivities

10. Peradeniya Alumni Website and On Line Magazine

Proposal to be developed covering the following as minimum: Define scope of website, structure of website, core content, core features, core controls, administration and security controls, rules of the content, editing panel and their scope.
