In May 2014, The Japanese ambassador opened a museum in a section of the University of Peradeniya main library in memory of the late Professor Ediriweera Sarachchandra.

Number of memorabilia depicting the late Professor Sarachchandra is now on display for public viewing.

It contains an array of articles and items relating to the life and times of Prof. Sarachchandra, the eminent academic, literary figure and dramatist including various forms of his attire, his literary works, drama manuscripts, articles and other literary contributions.

A museum in his memory was established at the Peradeniya University for the benefit of future generations.

Obituaries PROFESSOR G.P. WANNIGAMA.



Professor Wannigama, Professor of Chemistry, University of Peradeniya expired on March 14, 2014.

The death of Emeritus Professor Gladwin Percy Wannigama has removed from the Academia of

this country one of the longest serving, dedicated and committed of University teachers.

Professor Wannigama commenced teaching chemistry at University of Ceylon then in Colombo since 1951, just soon after he graduated with a first class honors degree in chemistry and winning the coveted Khan Gold Medal for Chemistry and with it the Ceylon Government scholarship to enable him to proceed to the U.K. to do a Doctorate in his chosen subject.

Professor Wannigama had earned the high accolades he has received from those he taught and the recognition of his services to many generations.

PROFESSOR RANJITH AMARASINGHE



Professor (Emeritus) Ranjith Amarasinghe, University of Peradeniya, expired on Sunday July 27, 2014. He was 73 when he passed away.

Professor Amarasinghe was not a mere academic but a social activist without personal ambition. He performed his tasks, whether as an academic or a social activist as if he was bound to do that duty by destiny.

To his academic credit, Ranjith obtained BA (Ceylon), B. Phil (York) and PhD (London) before venturing into broader areas of studies, research and social engagement. He could not be considered a politically neutral or an apolitical person.

Professor Amarasinghe held possitions of Head Political Science (1998 – 2008) and Dean of Arts Faculty (2003 – 2006), in the University of Peradeniya.
